The purpose of this contract is to protect the *Cedarhome Springers* Kennel reputation, bloodlines, the care and treatment of the puppy/dog and to clarify terms so as to prevent any future disagreements between the parties herein referred to as buyer and seller.

- If for any reason the buyer is unable to care for or keep this dog, it is to be returned to ***Cedarhome Springers***, at owner's loss.
- The purchaser must have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within two (2) business days of the purchase/pick-up/arrival.
- If during that time, a veterinarian finds a genetic or life threatening illness, puppy may be returned with certificated veterinarian findings for review by our own veterinarian. If the examination indicates that at the time of sale, such animal was unfit for purchase due to illness or disease, you may return the pet to ***Cedarhome Springers*** for an exchange of equivalent value.

Forty-eight (48) hours after this puppy/dog has left ***Cedarhome Springers*** we accept no responsibility for the dog's health or actions, nor will there be any refunds.

- If within two (2) years from the date of purchase, this dog is found and certified by a licensed veterinarian to have ***congenital or hereditary*** disorders which adversely and permanently affect the health of the animal; ***Cedarhome Springers*** must be notified within two (2) business days of the veterinarian's determination. Upon return of the dog, and concurrence by our own veterinarian, we will provide a replacement puppy of equivalent value.
- Buyer will have the option of keeping the dog, after discussing the findings with ***Cedarhome Springers***. However, ***Cedarhome Springers*** will not be responsible for veterinarian fees/ costs or shipping cost.

- There is no guarantee or warranty that the purchaser will be able to show or breed the pet. Breeding rights are by prior approval of ***Cedarhome Springers*** only. All others will be sold with a spay-neuter understanding, and limited AKC registration.

If full AKC registration with breeding rights is agreed upon, a separate addendum will be written and signed by both the purchaser and Cedarhome Springers stating the intention and any additional terms.

- In the event of any litigation in connection with this Guarantee, ***Cedarhome Springers*** shall be paid reasonable attorney fees by the purchaser. Venue and jurisdiction for litigation arising out of or related to this contract shall lie exclusively in Snohomish County, Washington State.
- **Limitation of Guarantee:**
- This guarantee is non-transferable. The dog must be in good physical condition. No replacement will be given if the female has been bred. No replacement will be given for hip dysplasia if the dog is/has been over weight or over exercised. No replacement if the registration application form has expired. You must follow AKC recommendations for weight classifications, and exercise restriction timetables. All dogs must not be over exercised *during their growth period*. Over exercising is as follows: running with the dog or jumping the dog. All the above mentioned conditions must be met or all guarantees above mentioned will be void. A licensed veterinarian must do all laboratory verification. The owner is responsible for transportation costs to and from the Seller. Seller is not responsible for any and all veterinarian expenses accumulated on returned or replaced dog or puppy. ***Cedarhome Springers*** sells pets for companion purposes only.

Cedarhome Springers reserve the right to re-acquire any dog originating from us found neglected or mistreated in any way, at any time during its natural expected life without recompense.

I, the *purchaser (or their representative)* of a puppy/dog from ***Cedarhome Springers***, hereby acknowledge that I have read and understood this document. Further, I accept the terms and conditions of the guarantee for congenital or hereditary disorders printed in this document, and I waive and relinquish any and all other rights that I might otherwise have in the event of such occurrence.

Upon signing this contract both buyers and seller certify they have read, agreed and fully understood the terms of this contract.
